**Roles and responsibilities of the Young Professional I are given below:**

- To undertake routine visits to Bhaderwah, as the main centre of experimentation and field trials will be located there, and actively participate in field and data collection activities at the site.
- Preparation of germplasm for sowing in experimental field and recording of morphological data on more than 700 germplasm lines. Assist in harvesting, storage and maintenance of importance germplasm.
- Managing field labour, laboratory screening of germplasm, digitalization of field data for bioinformatic and statistical data analysis and compiling project reports for further submission to funding/concerned agency.
